Exciting things were happening in the classrooms this month as well. Mrs. Prehm's preschool classes began studying weather and learning the differences between hot and cold temperatures. They also spent time learning about the February holidays of Ground Hog Day, Valentines Day and President's Day. During Bible time they learned how Jesus was baptized. In Mrs. Jones' preschool classes the students are working on vowel sounds in reading, and counting by 5s and 10s in math. They are also memorizing the Lord's Prayer.

Our Kindergarten class began studying dental care and animal habitats and hibernation. They are reading many stories and poems about teeth as well as animals, and they even created life-size penguins to hang on the classroom wall. The First and Second graders have been working hard in math. They have been studying congruent shapes and double digit addition. Finally, the Third and Fourth graders have completed the first round of State Testing. In Science and Social Studies they are studying the history of Presidents and land formations.
