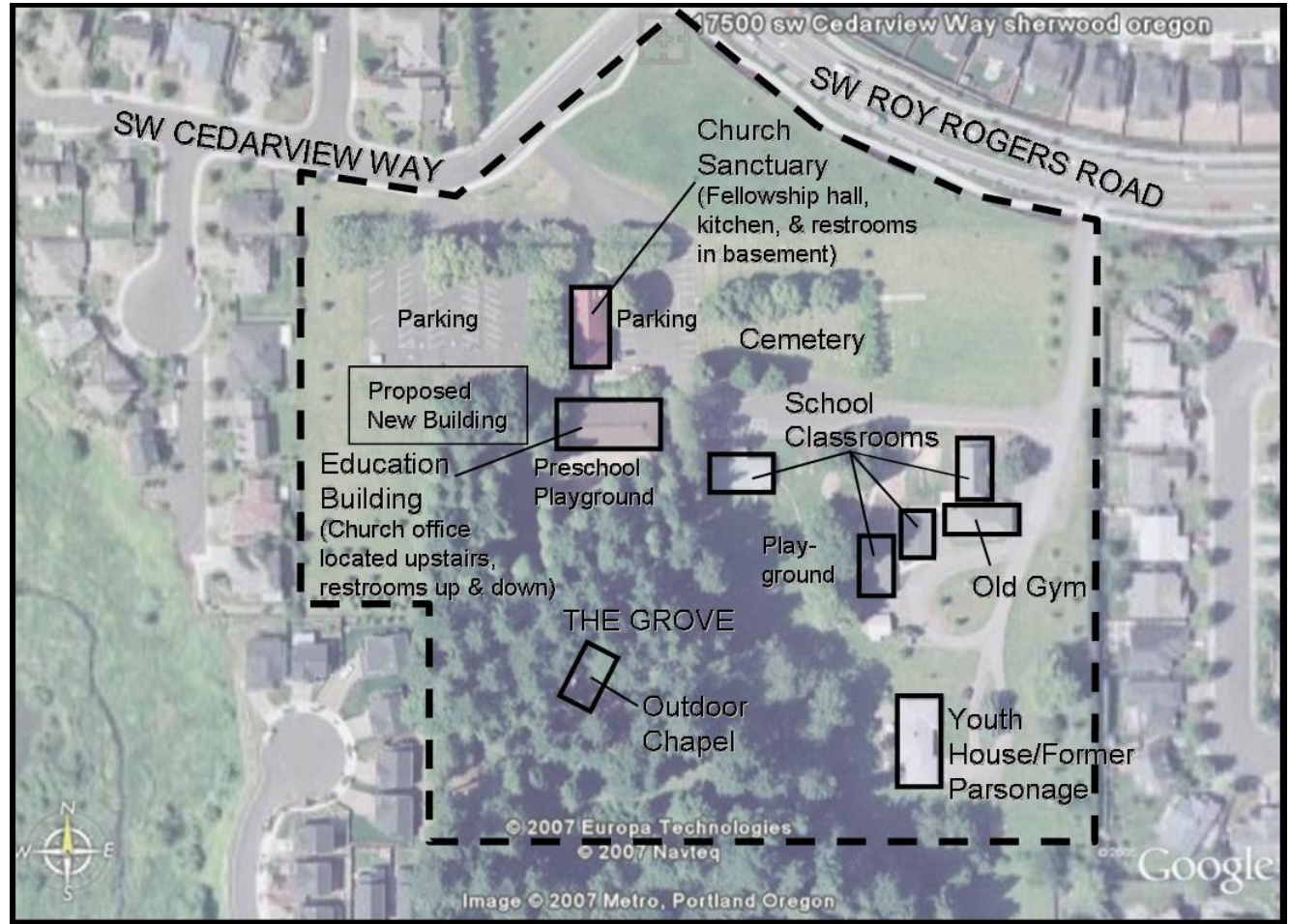
News regarding school closures is carried on all radio and TV stations starting early in the morning, giving school closures, late starts, and the status of any afternoon sessions.

Parents are responsible for transportation to and from school. An adult must escort the child into the classroom and from the waiting area. **Please notify the school if your child is to be picked up by someone other than the regular driver.** Children will be released only to those individuals designated by you as authorized drivers. You will be asked to list the names of designated drivers, their relationship to the child, make of car and license plate number. Any changes or additions must be reported to the office or the teacher in writing.



Please remain in your car while waiting to pick up your child. At the close of each session, the teacher and/or aide will escort each class to the pick-up area. You are expected to pick up your child from this area.

EARLY PICK UP: Please notify the teacher and /or office of the time you will picking up your child. Pick up your child from the classroom. Do not park on or over the yellow line, or leave your car running and unattended.

CARPOOLS: - *Please park your car in the parking lot (do not leave it running or unattended) then pick up car seats from the teacher .*
